
Hydlo and FRIENDS unplugged

Ecological Instream Flow:

Being waterly correct!



The Rupert River flows downstream of Rupert Dam. Hydro-Québec will be increasing the amount of water released to support spring spawning beginning in early May, the first change since May 2010.

An instream flow released year round through the spillway gates contributes to ensuring Hydro-Québec keeps its commitment to preserve fish habitat and the river's continued use for hunting, fishing, trapping and boating.

Rupert River Water Management Board

The Board oversees the respect of the Ecological Instream Flow regime. The Board counts two Cree members—Mr. Lawrence Jimiken, representing Nemaska, and Mr. Thomas Hester, representing Waskaganish—as well as Mr. Bryan Craik, representing the Grand Council of the Crees.
