Subject: Access to information request DAI-2022-0121

Good day.

We are writing in response to your access to information request received on March 28, 2022, in which you requested the following:

“... I'd like a copy of the current owners, per city or division, of each <Parc> or Groupment of Utility poles, a map if such a thing exists, but per city-- who is the owner of that specific group of utility poles.

Each city or division is a different group or <Parc> of Utility poles with different owners. I'd like a copy of that list or map.” (sic)

Further to your request, a map of utility pole locations is available on our website at <http://www.hydroquebec.com/location-structures/> (in French only). Click on the hypertext link “*Parcs de poteaux pour Google Earth [kmz 2,4 Mo] (mise à jour juillet 2021)*” to open the map.

On the map, the term *gestionnaire* [manager] of a pole group means being the owner of common poles belonging to the group. Common poles are common between Hydro-Québec and one of the following pole owners: Bell, Télébec or TELUS. Each of these pole groups has poles that are not considered to be common between the above-mentioned companies, and that remain therefore the property of the company that operates them. It should be noted that the map provides general information, but that exceptions may need to be verified in greater detail for specific structures, given that pole ownership changes all the time.
